As we celebrate our one-year anniversary, we honor the two saints whose lives continue to shape our mission—St. John Bosco and Blessed Carlo Acutis.




Blessed Carlo Acutis

(To Be Canonized September 2025) Born in 1991 and called home to God in 2006, Carlo Acutis was

a teenager with a love for the Eucharist, technology, and helping others grow in their faith. He created a website documenting Eucharistic miracles around the world and often said, "The Eucharist is my highway to Heaven."

Though he lived only 15 short years, his impact reached millions. Carlo reminds us that holiness is possible at any age, and in any setting—even online. His canonization, scheduled for September, will officially recognize what many of us already believe: that Carlo is a saint for our time.



St. John Bosco

A visionary educator and priest from the 1800s, St. John Bosco dedicated his life to serving youth—

especially the poor, forgotten, and at-risk. He believed that love, joy, and patience—not punishment—were the keys to guiding young hearts toward God. His legacy lives on through schools, oratories, and ministries around the world.

Why These Saints?

We chose Blessed Carlo and St. John Bosco as our patrons because their stories mirror our mission: reaching hearts across generations, creating joyful spaces to encounter Christ, and using the tools of today—technology, community, and mercy—to proclaim the Gospel boldly. A Year of Faith in Action

Over the past year, Eagle Rising Catholic Ministry (ERCM) has remained steadfast in its mission to live out the Gospel through both word and deed. Through God's grace, we've touched lives in profound ways.

We helped individuals secure employment and stable housing, provided clothing to those in need, and walked with families through difficult transitions. We extended our outreach to support local and national charities—including donating time and



resources to the **Sisters of Life**, a Catholic religious community dedicated to protecting the sacredness of

human life and offering loving support to women facing unplanned pregnancies. Our spiritual reach expanded globally as

well:

In Wisconsin, an ERCM ambassador journeyed the full 22-mile Walk to Mary,



carrying intentions for healing, family, and peace.

In Mexico, another ambassador delivered



written prayer petitions to the **Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, lighting candles and offering

intercession on behalf of our ministry. In Bermuda, ambassadors visited the historic St. Peter's Church in St. George's and the awe-inspiring **Unfinished**

Church, reflecting on God's ongoing work in each of us. From clothing drives to spiritual pilgrimages, ERCM's year was



filled with acts of faith, hope, and charity. As we look back, we are reminded that every prayer matters, every soul is sacred, and our mission to serve in Christ's name continues—stronger than ever.

Also recently in Louisiana, ERCM extended its mission of mercy by awarding ten \$1,500 scholarships to students at St. Elizabeth School in Paincourtville—one of the poorest



parishes in the state. Founded 150 years ago by the Carmelite Sisters, the school continues to serve families seeking

Catholic education amid financial hardship. "I am certain God heard the cry of our families for help, and the help came through Eagle Rising Scholarships," shared Principal Sandy Pizzolato. Fr. Tomi Thomas, pastor of St. Jules Church, added, "May God bless Eagle Rising Ministries, who take care of the vulnerable." For more information, call (929) 561-8301.
