Founder's Message



In Luke 8:45, the woman who suffered for twelve years was healed after touching the fringe of Jesus' garment. The garment itself had no power — it was

her faith and the contact with Jesus that brought healing.

Throughout history, God has worked through sacred items to manifest His power: the True Cross recognized by a miraculous healing, Elijah's cloak parting the Jordan, St. Paul's garments bringing healing, and St. Peter's shadow restoring the sick. In Catholicism, such items are known as relics:

- First Class from the body of a saint (hair, bone, blood)
- Second Class something the saint used (clothing, rosary, staff)
- Third Class anything touched to a First or Second Class Relic

Relics remind us that it is not the object itself that heals, but God's mighty hand working through our faith. Even faith as small as a mustard seed can unleash His power (Mark 11:22–24).

This September 7th, as we await the canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis — our **patron saint** — may we be inspired by his unwavering trust in God.

- -Use your words to encourage, not tear down.


Share your faith — in person, online, or through acts of kindness.

Saint of the Month: Blessed Carlo Acutis

(To Be Canonized September 7th, 2025)



Last month, we introduced you to Blessed Carlo Acutis — the young man whose love for the Eucharist, devotion to Our Lady, and creative use of

technology continue to inspire people around the world. This month, we return to him — not to repeat his story, but to go deeper — because Blessed Carlo is the chosen **patron saint** for Eagle Rising Catholic Ministry. His life and mission reflect the very heart of who we are and what we seek to do.

Carlo understood something many spend a lifetime searching for: that holiness is simply loving God with all your heart and serving Him with the gifts you've been given. He once said, "To be always close to Jesus, that's my life plan." For him, the Eucharist wasn't just a devotion — it was the center of his existence. His daily Mass, time spent in Eucharistic Adoration, and prayer were the source of his joy and the strength behind his service to others.

In his short life, Carlo faced challenges too — loneliness at times, misunderstandings, even illness. But he chose to unite his struggles with Christ's sufferings, offering them for the Church and for souls. As he battled leukemia, his focus never shifted from God's will. "I am happy to die because I lived my life without wasting even a minute on things that don't please God," he said shortly before his passing.

As we await his canonization September 7th, we recognize that Carlo's sainthood is not just a title — it is a call to action. For ERCM, his witness challenges us to keep Christ at the center of all we do, to use every available tool — from face-to-face ministry to modern technology — to share the Gospel, and to remember that our ultimate goal is Heaven.

Blessed Carlo Acutis, soon to be Saint Carlo, pray for us and guide our ministry to soar on wings of faith, hope, and love. ~*Andrea, Chairperson*~


