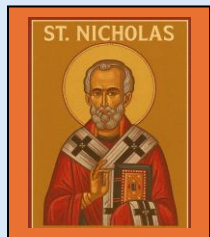

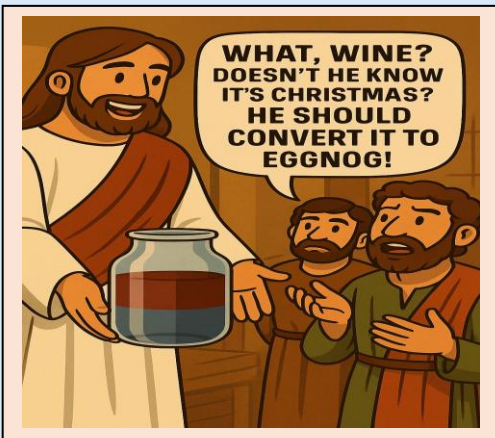

Ambassadors came together for an evening of prayer, reflection, and gratitude as we closed the month and prepared our hearts for the Christmas season.

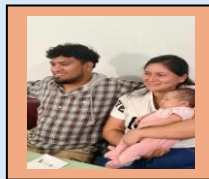
The evening began with a special blessing from Rev. Fr. Samy, who

appreciate the blessings, big and small, that God has placed in our lives.

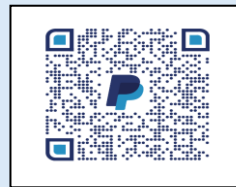
